In 1981 we left San Diego and went to the Philippines, where we lived on the island of Palawan to bring Christ to the Palawano people, an Unreached People Group of about 12,000.

We built a bamboo house. Then we had to learn the Palawano language. In 1985 we were able to present the Gospel, and we began translating the New Testament. As the church grew, we started training Palawano pastors.

Along the way, Bill helped lots of missionaries with language learning.

Fast forward to 2014, and by God's grace, our translation work was completed—God's Word is now in the hands of the Palawano churches.



They have a printed version of the New Testament, plus an audio version, and (believe it or not) an Android app.



After 33 years in the Philippines, we took a deep breath and shifted to an international ministry.

We asked God, "What next?" and he gave us a burden...

Missionaries all over the world need to learn unknown languages in order to reach the remaining 8,686 Unreached People Groups.

They need training in order to do this.

We're leveraging our years of experience to help them. The most exciting part is that missionaries are now rising up from China, Indonesia, the Philippines, Myanmar, Africa, Latin America... and THEY are the ones asking us for training.
